STATUS UPDATE

In his petition for a writ of habeas corpus under 28 U.S.C. § 2241, Petitioner challenges his most recent period of detention with the Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE). As relief, Petitioner seeks release from ICE custody. Since filing his petition, Petitioner has been removed from the United States. (*See* Exhibit A.) Petitioner was removed from the United States on December 29, 2025. Petitioner is no longer in ICE custody. As such, Petitioner has received all of the relief that he requested and to which he would be entitled if successful in his petition, so there is no further relief that the Court may award. Accordingly, the Court should dismiss the habeas petition for lack of jurisdiction as moot. *See, e.g., Chay v. Holder*, 470 F. App'x 406, 406–07 (5th Cir. 2012); *Singh v. Mukasey*, No. 3:08-CV-2162-O, 2009 WL 1097255, at *1 (N.D. Tex. Apr. 22, 2009); *Caquias v. Dist. Dir. of ICE*, No. 3:08-CV-1808-D, 2008 WL 5378173, at *1 (N.D. Tex. Dec. 23, 2008).

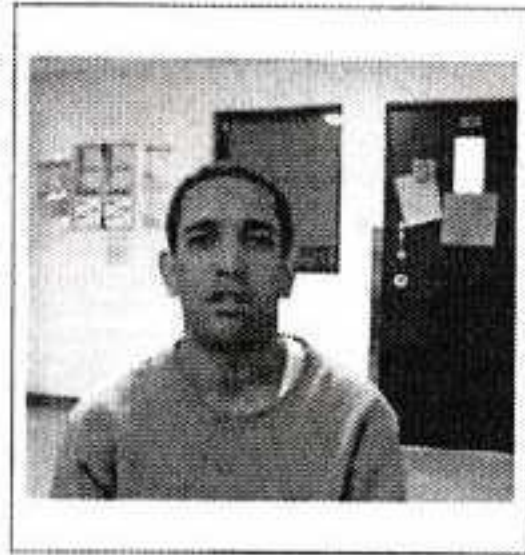

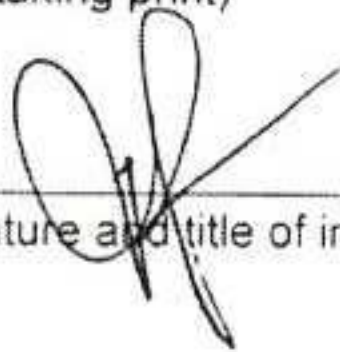
