Petitioner and Federal Respondents stipulate to a motion to revise the briefing schedule. Pursuant to the prior stipulation of the parties (dkt. 9), this Court ordered that Federal Respondents file a response to the habeas petition no later than October 10, 2025, and Petitioner file a reply no later than October 17, 2025 (dkt. 11).

In their response, Federal Respondents contended that the petition should be denied because an interview with the Consulate General of France is scheduled for October 15, 2025, and that, based on assurances from the Consulate General, ICE believes that a travel document will be issued (dkt. 12).

In order to allow Petitioner to see whether the interview takes place and the travel document issue, and advise the Court of the status of the case, the parties stipulate to a motion that Petitioner’s reply will be due October 24, 2025, rather than October 17 and that the petition be noted for October 17, 2025.
