SECOND STIPULATED MOTION TO
REVISE BRIEFING SCHEDULE

Petitioner and Federal Respondents stipulate to a motion to revise the briefing schedule. Pursuant to the prior stipulation of the parties (dkt. 8), this Court ordered that Federal Respondents file a response to the habeas petition no later than October 10, 2025, and Petitioner file a reply no later than October 17, 2025 (dkt. 11).

In their response, Federal Respondents contended that the petition should be denied because an interview with the Consulate General of France was scheduled for October 15, 2025, and that, based on assurances from the Consulate General, ICE believed that a travel document would be issued (dkt. 12).

The parties then filed a stipulated motion to continue the due date of Petitioner's response to October 24, 2025, so that Petitioner would have an opportunity to see whether the interview took place and the travel documents issued (dkt. 15). That motion is still pending.

Respondents have now advised Petitioner's counsel that the interview did take place on October 15, 2025, and that the travel documents and visa processing should be completed in the next few weeks.

1 Accordingly, the parties stipulate to a motion continuing Petitioner's response
2 for two weeks to October 31, 2025. They therefore withdraw the stipulated motion to
3 continue that response for only one week (dkt. 15). Depending on developments, one or
4 both parties may seek further continuances.
