THIRD STIPULATED MOTION TO
REVISE BRIEFING SCHEDULE

Petitioner and Federal Respondents stipulate to a motion to revise the briefing schedule. Pursuant to the most recent stipulation of the parties (dkt. 16), this Court ordered that Petitioner file a Reply to the Federal Respondent’s Response no later than October 31, 2025 (dkt. 17).

In their Response, Federal Respondents contended that the petition should be denied because an interview with the Consulate General of France was scheduled for October 15, 2025, and that, based on assurances from the Consulate General, ICE believed that a travel document would be issued (dkt. 12). After this court granted a stipulated motion to continue the due date of Petitioner’s response to October 24, 2025 (dkt. 15), it then granted a second stipulated motion to revise the briefing schedule, after the parties learned that the October 15th interview had occurred and Respondents’ counsel advised that ICE stated the travel document and visa processing should be completed in the “next few weeks.” Dkt. 16.

Respondents’ counsel has now advised Petitioner that ICE has called and emailed the consulate requesting a time frame on the issuance of the travel documents. ICE understands that the visa has been forwarded to the consulate from the visa center

1 (a private company contracted by France to process visa applications) and that the
2 consulate has assured ICE that they will issue a travel document.

3 Accordingly, the parties stipulate to a motion continuing Petitioner's response
4 for two additional weeks to November 14, 2025, to see whether travel documents in
5 fact will issue. Depending on developments, one or both parties may seek further
6 continuances.
