**NOTICE REGARDING PETITIONER’S BOND HEARING**

Pursuant to this Court’s order of October 16, 2025 (Dkt. No. 14), the federal respondents, through their undersigned counsel, hereby respectfully submit the instant notice regarding the bond hearing held with respect to the petitioner in the above-captioned habeas action.

**NOTICE**

In this habeas action, petitioner Sixto Hernandez Hernandez filed his petition for a writ of habeas corpus on September 18, 2025 (Dkt. No. 1). After full briefing (Dkt. Nos. 11-12), on October 16, 2025, this Court entered an order granting the petition, which directed, *inter alia*, that Hernandez Hernandez “be provided with a bond hearing by an Immigration Judge pursuant to 8 U.S.C. § 1226(a) within seven days” (Dkt. No. 11, at 6).

The Immigration Court held a bond hearing on October 20, 2025, and ordered Hernandez Hernandez released on a \$5,000 bond.
