

PETITION FOR WRIT OF HABEAS CORPUS

PURSUANT TO 28 U.S.C. § 2241

I, AYYUB HAYTHAM JAMIL HANNA, respectfully petition this Court for a writ of habeas corpus and state as follows:

- 1. I am detained by U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement ("ICE") at FCI Leavenworth, Federal Corrections Institution, Leavenworth, Kansas.
- 2. I was granted deferral of removal under the Convention Against Torture ("CAT"), which prohibits my removal to Iraq.
- 3. I have been in ICE custody for more than 180 days since my removal order became final.
- 4. ICE has attempted to remove me to third-party countries, but each of those countries has refused to accept me.
- 5. Because of my CAT protection and the refusals of third-party countries, there is no significant likelihood of removal in the reasonably foreseeable future.
- My continued detention therefore violates the Constitutions and Zadvydas v. Davis, 533 U.S. 678 (2001), which held that post-removal detention beyond six months is presumptively unreasonable when removal is not reasonably foreseeable.

RELIEF REQUESTED

I respectfully request this Court:

- a. Issue a writ of habeas corpus ordering my release from ICE custody under appropriate conditions of supervision; and
- b. Grant any other relief the Court deems just and proper.
