Petition of Habeus Corpus pursuant 28 U.S.C § 2241, Zadvydas v. Davis

- 1) I, Maulikkumar Patel is currently detained in FCI Berlin 1 success Loop Road, Berlin, NH 03570
- 2) I first arrived in US from Canada on 10/2022 as a political asylum seeker.
- 3) On 11/21/2022 I had my credible fear interview which was denied
- 4) On 12/16/2022 my credible fear interview was reviewed by the judge and was also denied.
- 5) On 02/2023 I was deported to India within 25 days because I possessed a travel document.
- 6) When I arrived in India I was [REDACTED]
[REDACTED] and had to leave India because my life was in danger.
- 7) On 03/2023 I once again arrived in the US from Canada and lived in Chicopee, Massachusetts.

- 8) On 05/26/2024 I was arrested for a charge of trespassing and was later released.
- 9) On 05/28/2024 I went to court for trespassing and was detained by ICE.
- 10) On 04/08/2025 my trespassing charges were dismissed.

- 11) On 03/03/2025 I went in front of an immigration judge for a trial hearing and was denied asylum.
- 12) I appealed that decision on March 26, 2025, which was dismissed.
- 13) I believe that it is not possible to get my travel document because the government of India restricts me from coming back.
- 14) I am not a flight risk, and I pose no danger to the community.
- 15) I am asking this honorable court to release me under the supervision until my travel document is secured for deportation.
