Respondents' Advisory to the Court Regarding Petitioner's Release

Respondents file this Advisory to update the Court on the status of Petitioner's custody status and bond hearing pursuant to the Court's order entered on October 15, 2025. ECF No. 14. Counsel apologizes to the Court for the overdue advisory. Counsel's focus was on the getting the order to DHS, effectuating it, and assisting opposing counsel with matters related to said order. In doing so, counsel failed to properly calendar the Court ordered notification requirement.

Respondents advise the Court that a bond hearing took place on October 21, 2025. Petitioner was granted release on a \$8,500 bond. *See Attached Bond Order.* Since that date, Petitioner has made multiple attempts at posting said bond, but each time it was rejected. As of the date of this filing, the bond was accepted and has been posted. DHS advised that Petitioner will be released tomorrow, October 28, 2025. Respondent's will update the Court with proof of release at that time.
