I write with the permission of counsel for Respondents to inform the Court that the parties do not intend to file additional briefs or other materials in this matter unless directed to do so by the Court.

On Friday, October 17, 2025, Respondents filed a brief in opposition to the petition in lieu of an answer. Although the Court had ordered an answer, Petitioner does not contend that a formal answer is required.
