RESPONDENTS' STATUS REPORT

Respondents submit the following Status Report pursuant to the Court's Order granting, in part, Petitioner Javier De Domingo Campos. ECF No. 33.

In his Petition, Petitioner sought habeas relief in the form of immediate release or a bond hearing. *See generally* ECF No. 1.

After briefing, the Court granted, in part, the Petition. *See* ECF No. 33. Specifically, the Court ordered Respondents to provide Petitioner with a bond hearing within seven days of the Order (on or before November 20, 2025). *Id.* at 5-6. The Court

also directed Respondents to include, in a status report, a copy of the warrant justifying Petitioner's arrest and detention. *Id.* at 6.

Pursuant to that order, Respondents provide the following status update. On November 19, 2025, Petitioner appeared for a bond hearing before an immigration judge. Petitioner was granted bond. See Exhibit 1 (Bond Order). Petitioner posted bond, and he was released from custody. A copy of the warrant (I-200) justifying Petitioner's arrest and detention is attached as Exhibit 2.

Respondents' counsel further informs the Court that since Petitioner's release, both parties have cooperated in working to resolve a post-custody issue. The parties expect that this issue will be resolved on or before November 26, 2025. Should the parties require any further assistance from the Court, they will file a Joint Status Report on or before December 1, 2025.
