This Office represents Respondents (the “Government”) in the above-captioned habeas proceeding brought by Petitioner Maria Jose Tumba Huamani (“Petitioner”). As directed by the Court (ECF No. 14), the Government writes to confirm that Petitioner will be released imminently from ICE’s custody.
