ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE

Upon the annexed declaration of Paul O'Dwyer, counsel for Petitioner, and all of the pleadings and proceedings previously had herein, it is hereby:

ORDERED that Respondents show cause before the Honorable Judge Mary Kay Vyskocil, United States District Judge, at the United States District Court for the Southern District of New York, 500 Pearl Street, New York NY, on the ___ day of November, 2025, at 9:30 a.m., or as soon thereafter as counsel can be heard, why the following orders should not be made:

- (i) directing Respondents to release Petitioner from immigration custody forthwith;
- and
- (ii) enjoining Respondents from moving Petitioner outside the Southern District of New York until further Order of this Court.

ORDERED that the service of a copy of this Order to Show Cause, together with the papers upon which it is granted, along with the Petition and supporting exhibits,

upon the Office of the US Attorney for the Southern District of New York, 86 Chambers Street, New York, NY 10007, on or before the ___day of November, 2025, be good and proper service; and it is further

ORDERED that pending the determination of this Order to Show Cause,

Defendants are:

(i) enjoined from transferring Petitioner outside of the jurisdiction of the Southern District of New York.
