<sup>1</sup> Although we previously suggested that Petitioner's release would render this matter moot, *see* ECF No. 12 at 2, Respondents do not presently request dismissal on mootness grounds. In fact, Petitioner disputes that the case is moot because U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement released Petitioner subject to an ankle monitor, which was a condition not expressly imposed by the Immigration Judge in the bond order, so in Petitioner's view, "the government has not fully complied with the Immigration Judge's order." Petitioner filed a motion before the Immigration Judge requesting a hearing regarding the ankle monitor.
