JOINT STATUS REPORT

On October 17, 2025, the Court granted Petitioner's Petition and ordered Respondents to provide Petitioner with a bond hearing within 7 days. The Court further ordered the parties to file a status report within 24 hours of the conclusion of the bond hearing.

On October 23, 2025, Petitioner appeared before an immigration judge (IJ) for a bond hearing. Petitioner was granted bond by the IJ and subsequently released from custody. Respondents reserved their right to appeal the bond determination.

The parties will update the Court within 30 days if the Respondents file an appeal or seek a stay of the bond order.
