
1 Petitioner Jose Enrique Arce-Cervera, through counsel, Karen S. Monrreal, Law Office of
2 Karen S. Monrreal, respectfully submits this status report pursuant to the Court's Order dated
3 October 28, 2025, (ECF No. 20) which requires the parties to provide a report detailing the status
4 of Petitioner's bond hearing.

5
6 On November 4, 2025, at 8:00 a.m., Petitioner appeared before the Las Vegas Immigration
7 Court for his custody redetermination (bond) hearing pursuant to 8 U.S.C. § 1226(a), as ordered
8 by this Court. After hearing testimony and reviewing the Petitioner's supporting documents,
9 which consisted of letters of support, proof of employment, and residence, Immigration Judge
10 Lindsay M. Roberts, granted Petitioner release on bond in the amount of \$6,000.00, with
11 Alternatives to Detention (ATD) to be imposed at the discretion of U.S. Immigration and
12 Customs Enforcement (ICE).

14 Petitioner's U.S. citizen fiancée has initiated the bond posting process with the ICE ERO
15 Bond Acceptance Unit. She has been approved to serve as the obligor and is currently awaiting
16 wire transfer instructions from ICE in order to complete the bond payment. Once those
17 instructions are received, the funds will be transmitted immediately to secure Petitioner's release.
18

19 Once the \$6,000 bond is posted and accepted, ICE will process the release of Petitioner from
20 the Nevada Southern Detention Center. As of the date of this submission, the Petitioner remains
21 in custody pending ICE's approval of his release. Counsel will promptly notify the Court should
22 any delay occur. This report is submitted in compliance with the Court's directive requiring a
23 status update on or before November 5, 2025.
