

1 Recommendation, after which there would be an opportunity for objection and
2 response. As a result, the matter would not be again before Judge Robert S. Lasnik for a
3 lengthy period.

4 **II. STIPULATED MOTION**

5 To avoid multiple rounds of briefing on the petition, the parties stipulate to the
6 following:

7 Petitioner will file a reply no later than December 1, 2025.

8 The Court will note the habeas petition for the date the reply is filed.

9 The parties further request that the Court terminate the referral to Magistrate
10 Judge Peterson in order to expedite a final ruling by the Court.
