**GROUND ONE:** My detention has been extended, reaching 114 days and approaching the stipulated time limit of 180 days without deportation. If I reach 181 days in detention, my Fifth Amendment due process rights would be violated.

I have had a deportation order since 03/11/2000, and I was captured by the ICE agency on 06/11/2025. I have been waiting for my deportation for 114 days. It should be noted that the United States does not have good diplomatic relations with vietnam, which makes my situation difficult.

**GROUND TWO:** Discrimination against me for my convictions and for not having a passport with me is delaying my removal to my country, and the ICE agency is not working exhaustively to obtain my passport.

Under new DHS policies requiring every convicted person to be detained and deported, I am being discriminated against for having a conviction, which is why I have been placed in a high risk ICE detention facility with other dangerous individuals in the detention dorms awaiting deportation.




