Status Report

On November 24, 2025, the Court entered an order requiring respondent to release petitioners or, in the alternative, provide them a bond hearing on or before December 2, 2025. (Order, ECF No. 11, PageID.212–13). Pursuant to the Court’s order, respondent certifies that the immigration court released petitioners Hurtado Medina and Perez-Perez on bond on December 2, 2025. The immigration court held a bond hearing for petitioners Polanco and Ramirez-Ramos on December 2, 2025, but denied their requests for release on bond because the immigration court found that they failed to meet their burden of demonstrating that they did not present a substantial flight risk.
