



1 As matters currently stand, Respondents would file a return no later than  
2 November 21, 2025, after which Mr. Panfilov would be entitled to file a traverse.  
3 Magistrate Judge Leupold would issue a Report and Recommendation, after which  
4 there would be an opportunity for objection and response. As a result, the matter would  
5 not be before Judge Tiffany M. Cartwright for a lengthy period.

6 **II. STIPULATED MOTION**

7 To avoid multiple rounds of briefing, the parties stipulate to the following:

8 Federal Respondents will file a response to the habeas petition no later than  
9 November 5, 2025. Any arguments that the petition should be dismissed shall be made  
10 in the response and not by separate motion.

11 Petitioner will file a reply no later than November 12, 2025.

12 The Court will note the habeas petition for November 12, 2025.

13 The parties further request that the Court terminate the referral to Magistrate  
14 Judge Leupold, in order to expedite a final ruling by the Court.

15 The Order directing Federal respondents to file a response to the petition within  
16 30 days (dkt. #9) will be stricken.
