

Urgent – Emergency Notice of Transfers and Imminent Removal Risk –
Humberto Romeu-Perez, A# [REDACTED] – Case No. 25-cv-03307-RMR

Dear Judge Regina M. Rodriguez,

I am the spouse of Humberto Romeu-Perez, A# [REDACTED] the petitioner in the above-referenced habeas corpus case. I respectfully submit this notice regarding his repeated transfers and risk of removal while his habeas petition is pending.

The habeas petition was filed on **October 22, 2025**, but Aurora Detention Center was **not served until November 20, 2025**, as confirmed by the docket entry on November 26, 2025. This delay has interfered with the timely consideration of the petition.

Since his detention beginning **June 21, 2025, at Krome, Florida**, Mr. Romeu-Perez has been **transferred numerous times**, which has negatively affected his health and access to consistent medical care. Most recently:

- **November 11, 2025**: Transferred to **Florence, Arizona**
- **November 16, 2025**: Returned to **Aurora, Colorado**
- **November 28, 2025**: Transferred to **Arizona**; he was **not interviewed or informed of next steps**
- **Last night (December 2nd)**: Transferred to **Port Isabel Detention Center, Texas**, without communication

Mr. Romeu-Perez **has expressed a genuine fear for his life and safety if removed to Mexico**, where he would be treated as an undocumented immigrant.

These repeated transfers interfere with his access to the federal court and may put him at risk of removal before the habeas petition is resolved. **We respectfully request that the Court issue an emergency order directing that Mr. Romeu-Perez be returned to Aurora Detention Center, where the habeas petition was filed and served in the District of Colorado, and that no further transfers or removals occur until the petition is fully resolved.**
