JOINT STATUS REPORT

Pursuant to this Court's Order, ECF No. 19, Petitioner Iman Mohamed Ali and Respondents Robert Hagan, Kristi Noem, Todd Lyons, and Pam Bondi² ("Respondents") hereby submit this Joint Status Report.

In his Petition for Habeas Corpus, ECF No. 1, Mr. Ali—a citizen and national of Somalia—challenged the lawfulness of his immigration detention on statutory and constitutional grounds. See ECF No. 1 at 54-61; ECF No. 3 at 8-21. On January 27, 2026, this Court granted the Petition, ordering that Respondents release Mr. Ali no later

than 48 hours after the issuance of the Order; that Mr. Ali be restored to be restored to his prior conditions of supervised release (OSUP); and that within five days of the Order, the Parties file a joint status report informing the Court of the status of Mr. Ali's release and whether any additional proceedings in this matter are required. ECF No. 19 at 13-14.

The Parties hereby confirm that, consistent with this Court's Order, Mr. Ali was released from immigration detention on January 29, 2026, subject to his prior conditions of supervised release. The Parties request that the Court enter a final judgment in this matter. Fed. R. Civ. P. 58(d).

Counsel for Mr. Ali notes that she intends to seek fees pursuant to the Equal Access to Justice Act and will timely file such a motion. See ECF No. 19 at 14 n.4.
