Plaintiff is in heart failure stemming from a rare genetic heart condition that requires specialized care unavailable in current detention settings. Pain and other symptoms have worsened over the past five months. Plaintiff has missed two cardiology appointments to adjust his pacemaker following open heart surgery in May 2025. Federal authorities have refused to release him or even transport him to obtain proper treatment.


