Dear Judge Cecchi:

This Office represents Respondents in the above-referenced habeas action. On December 23, 2025, the Court ordered the Respondents to provide Petitioner with an individualized bond hearing before an immigration judge within seven days. ECF 10. The Court also ordered the Respondents to file a written notice of the outcome of that hearing within three days. *Id.* On December 30, 2025, an immigration judge held a bond hearing and denied Petitioner release finding he posed a "significant flight risk." Accordingly, Respondents respectfully request the Court close this matter.
