Respondents' Status Report

Pursuant to the Court's order entered on November 5, 2025, Respondents file this advisory to inform the Court regarding the immigration court's bond decision. *See* ECF No. 7.

1. On November 13, 2025, Respondents provided a bond hearing pursuant to the Courts order. *See* Attached EOIR Order.
2. The immigration judge denied bond to Petitioner. The immigration judge stated a number of reasons for finding flight risk. Those included a presumption of ineligibility for asylum. It also included negative equities in the record, to include: manner of entry, use of another's Social Security number, and false identity, and reduced likelihood of relief. *See* Attached EOIR Order.
3. Petitioner intends to appeal the EOIR order.
