**STATUS REPORT**

On November 17, 2025, the Court entered an opinion and judgment granting Guillermina Amigon Cardona's petition for a writ of habeas corpus (ECF Nos. 10 and 11). The Court further ordered that Respondents file a status report certifying compliance with the Court's judgment.

The U.S. Department of Homeland Security (DHS) and the U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE) released Petitioner from custody on November 19, 2025<sup>1</sup>. The immigration court did not hold a bond hearing before ICE released Petitioner from custody.
