

1. The document I received does not contain the official court seal.
2. The signature included appears to be a printed signature rather than an original handwritten one, and there is no embossing or indentation on the back of the page that would normally accompany an authentic original signature.
3. The wording of the document appears inconsistent and lacks logical coherence.
4. I also did not receive any receipt or confirmation regarding the \$5 filing fee associated with a habeas corpus petition.

For these reasons, I respectfully request the Court to confirm the authenticity of the document I received and to provide an update on the current status of my habeas corpus case.
