**Federal Respondents' Advisory to the Court Regarding Petitioner's Release**

Federal<sup>1</sup> Respondents file this Advisory to notify the Court of Petitioner's physical removal from the United States, which action moots this habeas challenge to the legality of his detention. *See Bacilio-Sabastian v. Barr*, 980 F.3d 480, 483 (5th Cir. 2020); *Ortez v. Chandler*, 845 F.2d 573, 575 (5th Cir. 1988); *Riley v. I.N.S.*, 310 F.3d 1253, 1257 (10th Cir. 2002); *Virani v. Huron*, 2020 WL 7405655, at \*3 (W.D. Tex. Dec. 17, 2020). On or about October 20, 2025, Petitioner brought this habeas claim, seeking release from detention. ECF No. 1. On October 24, 2025, ICE removed Petitioner. Exh. A (executed DHS form I-205 (redacted)). The main relief Petitioner sought, namely release, has already occurred. This petition is, therefore, moot.
