**JOINT STATUS REPORT PURSUANT

In its December 8, 2025 minute order, the Court asked the parties to jointly respond to the following question:

² Bruce Scott is not a federal employee and is not represented by the undersigned in these proceedings. All other respondents, which are represented by the undersigned, are referred to as "Federal Respondents."

1 Petitioner Mohammad Muzami Yousufi has filed a motion to dismiss Bruce Scott
2 as a defendant in this matter, stating that Petitioner is no longer detained at the
3 Northwest ICE Processing Center. Dkt. No. [10]. The parties are directed to file a
joint status report within seven (7) days of this Order addressing Petitioner's current
custody status and whether any claims in this matter have been rendered moot.

4 Currently, the Petitioner has been released from custody on bond, pursuant to an order of
5 an immigration Judge. Nevertheless, because ICE still plans to exercise its statutory authority to
6 remove the Petitioner to a third country, and because the Petition seeks to enjoin ICE from
7 removing Petitioner to a third country, the parties agree that the issues raised in the Petition are
8 not moot.
