Dear Judge Broderick,

I hope that you are doing well and had a restful holiday season. I am very sorry to bother you at this time.

I filed my reply to the government's arguments on December 23, when it was due. Since then, my baby has remained in the hospital. My wife is really struggling to be there for her in the hospital while also taking care of our other children and running our restaurant. Since I am not there to help, our kids sometimes have to go with my wife to the restaurant in the evenings, when they should be doing their homework or playing like other kids. While we normally sell 100 plates of food per day, we are now able to sell only 20 plates of food per day and it is becoming very difficult for my wife to pay our bills without my support. Just yesterday, our restaurant was robbed while only my wife was present. We are lucky that our kids weren't there, but my wife was terrified. She is already barely able to sleep because of all the work she currently has to do on her own.

I ask you with respect and from the bottom of my heart to please make a decision in my case and to let me go home to my family.
