STATUS REPORT

As ordered by the Court, the Government provides the following status update:

According to Department of Homeland Security (DHS), a bond hearing was held for Petitioner on November 13, 2025, at 1:00 pm, before Immigration Judge Cho. After the hearing, Immigration Judge Cho granted release upon posting of a bond in the amount of \$3,000. DHS reserved its right to appeal the release order.

DHS has been advised that Petitioner will post bond if he has the funds. As of the time of filing of this Status Report, the bond has not yet posted in

accordance with the procedures established for bond posting by Immigration and Customs (ICE) Enforcement and Removal Operations (ERO).¹
