**Joint Advisory of Factual Stipulations**

Pursuant to the Court's Order [ECF No. 12], the Parties advise the Court of the factual stipulations:

1. Petitioner is a citizen and national of India.
2. On January 7, 2025, Citizenship and Immigration Services issued Petitioner an Employment Authorization Card. ECF No. 1 at 14.
3. On or about October 1, 2025, ICE detained Petitioner near Houston, Texas.
4. On October 2, 2025, ICE filed Petitioner's Notice to Appear with the immigration court alleging he is inadmissible under INA §§ 212(a)(6)(A)(i); 212(a)(7)(A)(i)(I).
5. On October 15, 2025, an immigration judge did not take action on Petitioner's request for a change in custody status pursuant to the Board of Immigration Appeals decision in *Matter of Yajure Hurtado*, 29 I&N Dec. 216 (BIA 2025). ECF No. 1 at 11.
6. Petitioner is scheduled for a master calendar hearing before the immigration judge on December 16, 2025.
