THIS MATTER comes before the Court on Petitioners' Motion for a Temporary Restraining Order and Preliminary Injunction. Having considered the motion, the memorandum and exhibits in support thereof, and any subsequent submissions related to the motion, the Complaint, in particular the fact that **ICE communicated to Counsel for Petitioners that they will be removing Petitioners from the United States back to Ecuador on November 6, 2025 at 2:30 am**, and the applicable law, the Court ORDERS as follows:

1. Petitioners' Motion for a Temporary Restraining Order is GRANTED.
2. Defendants, and all of their officers, agents, servants, employees, attorneys, successors, assigns, and persons acting in concert or participation with them, are hereby ENJOINED and RESTRAINED from removing Petitioners from the United States.

3. Pending consideration, Defendants are hereby RESTRAINED from detaining the Petitioners for the purposes of civil immigration detention;
4. The Court further ORDERS that Defendants, and all of their officers, agents, servants, employees, attorneys, successors, assigns, and persons acting in concert or participation with them, must TRANSFER Petitioners back to this Court's jurisdiction.
5. The Defendants must immediately REUNIFY the Lead Petitioner with her daughter, Evelyn.
6. The Defendants must PRODUCE the Petitioners to appear virtually for the SIJS hearing before the Queens County Family Court on November 10, 2025 at 2:00PM;
7. No security bond is required under Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 65(c).
8. Respondents are ORDERED to file a return as to why the Petition should not be granted by November 5, 2025 at 10:00 am
9. Petitioner shall have an opportunity to reply by November 5, 2025;
10. The merits of the Petition shall be heard by the Court on November 5, 2025.
11. And such other and further relief as the Court may find appropriate;
12. Service of this Order shall be effected by Petitioner on the United States Attorney for the by electronic mail by 5:00 m on November 4, 2025, and shall constitute good and sufficient service.
13. It is so ORDERED.
