RESPONDENTS' STATUS REPORT

COME NOW Respondents, Pamela J. Bondi, Attorney General of the United States, Kristi Noem, Secretary, Department of Homeland Security, Todd M. Lyons, Acting Direct, ICE, and Sylvester Ortega, Field Office Director for Detention and Removal, ICE, by and through the United States Attorney for the Western District of Texas and hereby file their Status Report confirming that Brayan Ariel Navarrete Perdomo has been released:

1) On November 25, 2025, the Court ordered 1) Respondents to release Petitioner Brayan Ariel Navarrete Perdomo ("Navarrete Perdomo") from custody by no later than 10:00 a.m. on November 26, 2025; 2) Respondents to notify Navarrete Perdomo's counsel of the exact location and exact time of Petitioner's release as soon as practicable and no less than two hours before her release; 3) and ordered parties to file a Joint Status report no later than 4:00 p.m. November 26, 2025, confirming that Navarrete Perdomo has been released. ECF No. 12.

2) Petitioner Navarrete Perdomo was released from custody on November 25, 2025, at 7:45 p.m. Navarrete Perdomo's counsel was notified of the exact location and exact time of Petitioner's release on November 25, 2025.

3) On November 26, 2026, Respondents' emailed Navarrete Perdomo's counsel to discuss the Joint Status Report. Respondent did not hear back from counsel and thus file this unilateral Status Report.
