

officers told Petitioner that he could wait in the waiting area for family to pick him up. Undersigned counsel immediately reached out to Clay and Respondents' Counsel to confirm the veracity of the statements and arrange transportation. Given that I had been in contact with the facility and Mr. Press earlier that same day, it would have been useful to have had received the notification of the government's intent to release Petitioner earlier in the day. Petitioner's family was able to drive to Indiana to pick him up before midnight. He is reunited with his family.

(3) Opposing Counsel communicated to Undersigned Counsel that a Bond Hearing was scheduled for Monday, November 10, 2025.

Prior to Petitioner's release, Respondents' counsel informed undersigned counsel that a bond hearing had been scheduled for Monday, November 10, 2025. Since Petitioner was released on November 6, 2025, and Respondents no longer had custody of Petitioner, the hearing did not go forward.
