STATUS REPORT CONCERNING PETITIONER'S RELEASE

Pursuant to this court's minute orders of November 11 and 12, 2025, Dkt. Nos. 11 and 12, Respondents, by their undersigned attorney, submit the following status report.

U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement has confirmed to the undersigned that the petitioner was released from the Clay County Justice Center on November 6, 2025. This is the same day that petitioner's counsel "reached out to Clay County Jail . . . to arrange a call with Petitioner." Dkt. 13.

Since that day, respondents have not been able to facilitate communication between petitioner and his counsel because respondents do not have him within their custody. Similarly, the previously scheduled bond hearing for November 10, 2025 mentioned by petitioner's counsel, Dkt. 13, was not in compliance with this court's temporal deadline of November 7, 2025 for such a proceeding to occur, Dkt. 7. Respondents consequently thought it best to release the petitioner in that circumstance, as doing so would both comply with this court's order regarding either a bond hearing or release, and simultaneously facilitate communication between the petitioner, his

counsel, and his family (as this court's order of November 5, 2025 only required "phone access *while in detention*" (emphasis added)).

In sum, because the petitioner has now obtained the relief that was sought via habeas, Dkt. 1 at 18, respondents believe this case is over.
