

1 Here, Cabezas Lopez's habeas claim challenges her detention, and does not allege any
2 collateral consequence that can be addressed by this Court. Now that she is no longer in custody,
3 her habeas claim is moot. *Abdala*, 488 F.3d at 1065 (describing habeas petitions that claim
4 indefinite detention as fully resolved and rendered moot by the petitioner's release from
5 custody); *Babak v. ICE FOD*, 20-cv-212-RSM-BAT, 2020 WL 1976798, at *1 (W.D. Wash.
6 Mar. 31, 2020) *R&R adopted by* 2020 WL 1974335, at *1 (W.D. Wash. Apr. 24, 2020)
7 (dismissing habeas petition as moot after ICE released petitioner on supervision).
