Respondents' Status Report

COMES NOW Respondent, Pamela J. Bondi, Attorney General of the United States, Kristi Noem, Secretary, Department of Homeland Security, Todd M. Lyons, Acting Direct, ICE, and Sylvester Ortega, Field Office Director for Detention and Removal, ICE, by and through the United States Attorney for the Western District of Texas and hereby file their status report confirming that Nestor David Hernandez Hervert was granted a bond hearing pursuant to the Court's Order. ECF No. 7.

1) On November 14, 2025, the Court ordered either (1) within seven days, Petitioner be granted an individualized bond hearing pursuant to 8 U.S.C. § 1226(a), where the necessity of his continued detention was to be determined on the basis of his flight risk or danger to the community, or (2) if Respondents did not grant such hearing, release Petitioner from custody.

2) On November 20, 2025, a bond hearing was held. *See* Exh. A at 1 (Immigration Judge's Order dated Nov. 20, 2025). Bond was granted and set at \$12, 500 with additional conditions of release imposed. *Id.* at 3. Petitioner has not yet posted bond or been released.
