**PLAINTIFF'S MOTION TO REOPEN CASE/RESPONSE TO COURT  
REGARDING FILING FEE FOR PETITION FOR WRIT OF HABEAS  
CORPUS**

COMES NOW, the Plaintiff, **Michael Olibrices**, pursuant to **Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 60(b)** and the inherent authority of this Honorable Court, and respectfully moves to **reopen the above-captioned case**, which was administratively closed, and in support thereof states as follows:

1. On or about **November 5<sup>th</sup>, 2025**, the Court entered an Order administratively closing this case for procedural purposes only. See **Docket Entry No. 3**.
2. The closure was **not a dismissal on the merits**, but an administrative action pending further compliance or payment of the filing fee of \$5.00.
3. The **required filing fee** has now been **submitted and attached** contemporaneously with this Motion.
