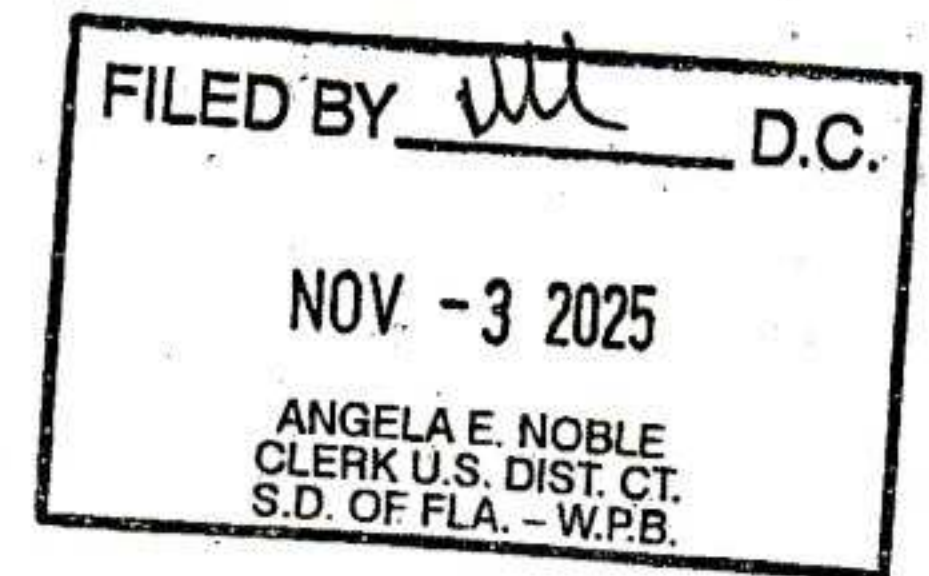

PETITION FOR WRIT OF HABEAS CORPUS

INTRODUCTION

1. Petitioner, Uriel Ramon Landero Fernandez, is a 40-year-old citizen of Nicaragua who has been in ICE custody since September 9, 2025, and is currently detained at Glades County Detention Center in Moore Haven, Florida.

2. Petitioner has a pending asylum application, valid work authorization, no criminal history, and family ties in Florida. His prolonged detention, despite full compliance, is unlawful and unconstitutional.

3. Accordingly, Petitioner seeks a writ of habeas corpus ordering his immediate release or, alternatively, a bond hearing.

JURISDICTION

4. This action arises under the Constitution of the United States and the Immigration and Nationality Act (INA), 8 U.S.C. § 1101 et seq.

5. This Court has subject matter jurisdiction under 28 U.S.C. § 2241 (habeas corpus), 28 U.S.C. § 1331 (federal question), and Article I, § 9, cl. 2 of the United States Constitution (Suspension Clause).

6. This Court may grant relief pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 2241, the Declaratory Judgment Act (28 U.S.C. § 2201), and the All Writs Act (28 U.S.C. § 1651).

VENUE

7. Venue is proper under 28 U.S.C. § 1391(e) because Petitioner is detained at Glades County Detention Center, located within this District.

REQUIREMENTS OF 28 U.S.C. § 2243

8. Under 28 U.S.C. § 2243, the Court must grant the writ or issue an order to show cause forthwith unless Petitioner is not entitled to relief.

9. Courts have long recognized habeas corpus as essential to liberty. See *Fay v. Noia*, 372 U.S. 391, 400 (1963).

PARTIES

10. Petitioner, Uriel Ramon Landero Fernandez, is a native and citizen of Nicaragua. He entered the United States in 2021 seeking asylum.

11. Respondent Kristi Noem is Secretary of DHS.

12. Respondent Patrick J. Lechleitner is Acting Director of ICE.

13. Respondent Warden, Glades County Detention Center, is Petitioner's immediate custodian.

14. Respondent, the Attorney General of the United States, oversees EOIR and immigration courts.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

15. Petitioner entered the U.S. in 2021 fleeing political persecution in Nicaragua.
16. He has no criminal record and possesses valid work authorization.
17. On September 9, 2025, ICE apprehended him in Florida while his asylum case was pending.
18. Petitioner's detention continues indefinitely without cause or foreseeable removal, in violation of due process.
19. He has family and housing support available through his cousin, Odell Landeros.

CLAIMS FOR RELIEF

COUNT ONE – VIOLATION OF FIFTH AMENDMENT DUE PROCESS

20. Petitioner incorporates paragraphs 1–19. His detention violates his substantive and procedural due process rights.

COUNT TWO – VIOLATION OF THE IMMIGRATION AND NATIONALITY ACT

21. Petitioner incorporates paragraphs 1–20. His continued detention violates 8 U.S.C. § 1231 and related regulations.

PRAYER FOR RELIEF

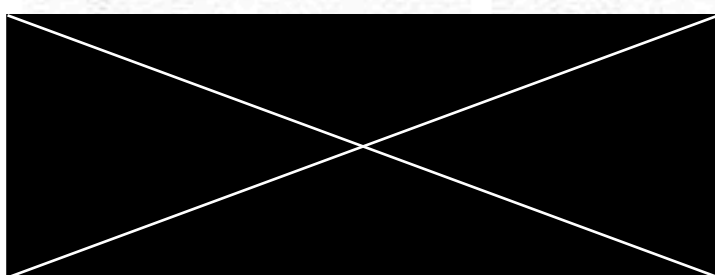
WHEREFORE, Petitioner respectfully requests the Court to:

- a. Assume jurisdiction over this matter;
- b. Order Respondents to show cause within three days;
- c. Declare detention unlawful under the Fifth Amendment and 8 U.S.C. § 1231;
- d. Grant the writ and order immediate release or a bond hearing;
- e. Award costs and further relief as appropriate.

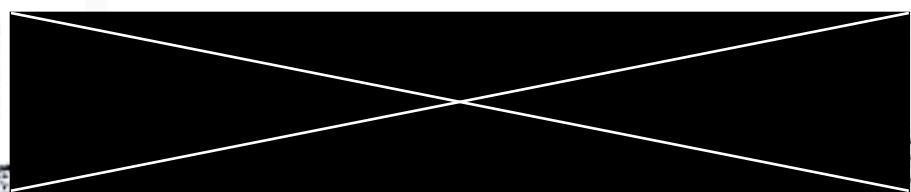
