I. INTRODUCTION

Pursuant to the Order entered on November 6, 2025, Dr. Jesus Estuardo Lujan Irastorza, ("Petitioner"), by and through undersigned counsel, moves this Honorable Court to reopen Case No. 3:25-cv02981-CAB-KSC. This motion is timely as it is brought before the Court imposed deadline of January 5, 2026.

II. STATEMENT OF FACTS AND OF THE CASE

On October 29, 2025, pro se Petitioner filed Petition for Writ of Habeas Corpus along with a Motion to Proceed in Forma Pauperis.

On November 6, 2025, the Court denied Petitioner's request to proceed in forma pauperis for failure to satisfy the filing fee requirement and dismissed this case without prejudice, with the option to have it reopened upon satisfaction of (1) a copy of this Order together with the \$5.00 filing fee; or (2) a copy of this Order together with adequate proof that the Petitioner cannot pay the \$5.00 filing fee. Respondent has since retained pro-bono Counsel and has satisfied the filing fee requirements.

III. CONCLUSION

For the foregoing reasons, the Court should grant this motion to reopen.
