Pursuant to Rule 65(b)(1) of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure, and CivLR 83.3(g)(2), Petitioner hereby moves the Court for emergency relief in the form of a temporary restraining order directing Respondents to release Petitioner from his custody or provide Petitioner with an individualized bond hearing before an immigration judge pursuant to 8 U.S.C. § 1226(a) within seven days of issuance of an Order.

Petitioner also seeks a temporary restraining order enjoining the Respondents from relocating Petitioner outside of the Southern District of California pending final resolution of this case.

Petitioner further moves for the issuance of an order to show cause as to why a preliminary injunction should not issue.

This application is supported by a Memorandum of Points and Authorities, accompanying exhibits, as well as any additional submissions that may be considered by the Court.

As described in the Declaration of Counsel below, counsel for Respondents has been provided with advance notice of this filing.
