STATUS REPORT

By and through undersigned counsel, Defendants respectfully provide this status report.

The undersigned has been informed by Immigration and Customs Enforcement (“ICE”) of the following. As of this filing, Plaintiff has been removed to Ghana after receiving a negative finding of fear as to Plaintiff’s removal to Ghana and is no longer in the custody of the United States.

In light of these developments, the Court can provide no relief in this case. *See D.A. v. Noem*, Civ. A. No. 25-3135 (TSC), 2025 WL 2646888, at * (D.D.C. Sept. 15, 2025) (“there is no question that the court lacks the power to order the Executive Branch to order Ghana to keep Plaintiffs in Ghana or to order the Executive Branch to notify the Ghanaian government not to remove Plaintiffs to their countries of origin or other countries where they fear persecution or torture” (citation modified)). If the Court believes otherwise, consistent with the approach taken by another judge in this district, the Court should promptly transfer this case to the District of Massachusetts as related to a pending class action challenging the government’s removal of deportable aliens to third countries, *D.V.D. v. Department of Homeland Security*, Civ. A. No. 25-10676 (D. Mass.). *See* Min. Order, *Phan v. Dep’t of Homeland Sec.*, Civ. A. No. 25-2147
