**JOINT STATUS REPORT**

1. The Parties submit this Status Report to advise the Court of recent developments.
2. On November 26, 2025, the Parties agreed that Petitioner be released from the custody of U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement (“ICE”) and given forty-five (45) days to prepare to voluntarily depart the United States.
3. Petitioner was released from ICE detention on December 4, 2025 and placed in the ICE Alternative to Detention Program (“ATD”) and was supervised through a global positioning tracking system (GPS) ankle monitor.
4. Petitioner cut off her GPS ankle monitor on December 28, 2025, and was last located at 9319 Bells Mill Road, Potomac, MD 20854.
5. Counsel for Petitioner has not had any communication with Petitioner since mid-December, and the phone numbers he had to contact her have been disconnected.
6. Petitioner’s current whereabouts are unknown to her counsel and Respondents.
