



Petitioner filed the instant action to seek relief from this court after she was taken into custody by the Respondents. After the Petitioner filed her petition with this Court a class was certified, and a nationwide injunction was issued by the Central District of California restraining EOIR from denying bonds to individuals similarly situated as the Petitioner. *See Bautista et al. v. Santacruz Jr. et al* 5:25-cv-01873 (C. D. Cal Nov. 25, 2025)(Dkt. 82) The Plaintiff will now seek a bond hearing directly with the Defendants pursuant to her Bautista Class Membership.

For the foregoing reasons, the Petitioner respectfully requests that the Court grant her motion to voluntarily dismiss without prejudice.
