**JOINT STATUS
UPDATE**

On December 2, 2025, this Court ordered the parties to provide a status update as to the results of the hearing referenced in the Declaration of John D. Ligon [Docket No. 11], which stated in paragraph 8 that Petitioner has a hearing in St. Paul scheduled for December 3, 2025. ECF 13 at 9 ¶ d. This Court further ordered the parties to update the Court regarding the outcome of any bond hearing held in immigration court. ECF 13 at 9 ¶ e.

The December 3, 2025 merits hearing was cancelled. On December 4, 2025, the immigration court held a bond hearing, and the Immigration Judge ordered Petitioner to be released upon payment of \$3,000 bond.

The Court can now enter judgment for Petitioner consistent with its Order and dismiss Petitioner's remaining requests for relief. Petitioner has received the bond hearing he requested, and the Court's December 2, 2025, declaration that Petitioner is subject to detention under § 1226(a)(1), not § 1225(b)(2), continues to apply until that declaration is amended, vacated, or overturned. Petitioner's asserted injury has therefore been remedied, and no issues remain for the Court's resolution.
