

2. As of the date of this motion, the Court has not issued an order to show cause, an order directing the Government to respond, or any other action indicating the procedural posture of the case.
3. Pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 2243, a court receiving a habeas petition “shall forthwith award the writ or issue an order directing the respondent to show cause why the writ should not be granted,” reflecting Congress’s intent that habeas petitions be handled promptly due to the liberty interests at stake.
4. Petitioner recognizes and respects the Court’s substantial caseload and the demands placed upon judicial resources. However, the length of time elapsed—now approaching a month and has left the Petitioner uncertain regarding the status of the case and the next steps in its adjudication.
5. Petitioner therefore respectfully requests that this Court:
 - a. Provide an update regarding the status of the habeas petition;
 - b. Issue an order referring the matter to a magistrate judge pursuant to 28 USC 636(b) or direct the Respondent to file an answer or other response; and
 - c. Grant any other relief the Court deems just and proper.

WHEREFORE, Petitioner respectfully prays that this Honorable Court considers the foregoing and take such action as is appropriate under the circumstances.
