ADVISORY REGARDING CUSTODY STATUS

Respondents submit this advisory to apprise the Court of Petitioner's current custody status.

Petitioner was scheduled to have a custody redetermination hearing on December 2, 2025. Immigration Court hearings do not take place at the detention center housing Petitioner but rather at the El Paso Service Processing Center (EPC). *See* Exh. A (C. Vasquez Declaration). Due to intake and processing errors at EPC the hearing did not take place. *Id.*

After the failed hearing, on December 2, 2025, ICE began processing petitioner for release. *See* Exh. A (C. Vasquez Declaration); *see also* Exh. B (December 2 Release Paperwork). Due to logistical and safety issues the release was delayed and did not take place timely. *See* Exh. A (C. Vasquez Declaration).

On December 3, 2025, Respondents released Petitioner on an Order of Release on Recognizance. *See* Exh. B (December 2 Release Paperwork). Petitioner is no longer in the Respondents' custody.
