STIPULATED DISMISSAL OF HABEAS CORPUS PETITION

On November 14, 2025, Petitioner filed a habeas corpus with this Court, challenging his prolonged detention in immigration custody at the Stewart Detention Center in Lumpkin, GA, after being detained for more than six months with an administratively final order of removal (ECF, 1). As part of its Response, Deportation Officer Santiago wrote that Petitioner’s removal was scheduled to take place on or before December 15, 2025 (5-1, at ¶ 15). As of December 15, 2025, Petitioner no longer appears in the ICE Online Detainee Locator. Further, counsel for Respondent has confirmed the Petitioner is no longer detained.

Therefore, both sides recognize that this Court can no longer give Petitioner any meaningful relief regarding his detention because the petition is moot. *See H.T. v. Warden, Stewart Det. Ctr.*, No. 4:20-cv-146-CDL-MSH, 2020 WL 12656230, at *2-6 (M.D. Ga. Dec. 29, 2020), *recommendation adopted*, 2021 WL 5444776 (M.D. Ga. Feb. 23, 2021); *see also, Al Najjar v. Ashcroft*, 273 F.3d 1330, 1336 (11th Cir. 2001) (discussing mootness).

Accordingly, both parties submit this Stipulated Dismissal of Habeas Corpus Petition with the Court.
