MOTION FOR EMERGENCY MEDICAL ORDER

(In Support of Petition for Writ of Habeas Corpus)

TO THE HONORABLE COURT:

Comes now the undersigned, on behalf of Mr. Luis Ernesto Araujo Molina, respectfully moving this Honorable Court to issue an **Emergency Medical Order** directing the Department of Homeland Security (DHS), Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE), and the El Paso Processing Center to **immediately provide essential medical care** to the detainee, who is a **Type 2 diabetic** and has been denied his prescribed medication since **October 15, 2025**.

I. FACTUAL BACKGROUND

1. The detainee, Mr. Luis Ernesto Araujo Molina, a Venezuelan national, was arrested on **October 15, 2025**.

2. He has a **prior order of deportation issued in 2024**.
3. Since his recent transfer to the **El Paso Processing Center (Montana Ave., Texas)**, he has been **denied access to his diabetes medication (Metformin 500mg)**.
4. Mr. Araujo Molina has suffered from **diabetes since age 20** and requires consistent treatment to prevent serious complications such as **hyperglycemia, coma, or organ failure**.
5. On the weekend following his transfer, he was **scheduled for deportation**, placed on a flight, and then **removed from the aircraft before takeoff**, despite his belongings being sent to Venezuela.
6. A **witness confirmed** that officers called his name as the plane was departing, realizing he had been taken off and returned to custody.
7. Since his return to the detention center, his **communication PIN has not been activated**, preventing him from making phone calls, accessing commissary, or obtaining food and hygiene items.
8. He has **not appeared before any court** since his detention began.

II. LEGAL BASIS

1. Under **28 U.S.C. § 2241** and the **All Writs Act (28 U.S.C. § 1651)**, federal courts have the authority to issue emergency orders to prevent irreparable harm to individuals in federal custody.
2. The **Eighth Amendment** prohibits deliberate indifference to serious medical needs (*Estelle v. Gamble*, 429 U.S. 97 (1976)).
3. The **Fifth Amendment's Due Process Clause** guarantees humane treatment for all persons detained by the U.S. government.
4. ICE Health Service Corps policy requires that detainees receive timely medical treatment and access to necessary prescriptions.

III. REQUEST FOR EMERGENCY RELIEF

The undersigned respectfully requests that this Honorable Court issue an **Emergency Medical Order** directing:

1. That **Mr. Luis Ernesto Araujo Molina** immediately receive his prescribed **Metformin 500mg** and any additional treatment required for his diabetic condition.
2. That a **licensed physician** perform a **full medical evaluation** and submit a report to the Court within **48 hours**.
3. That ICE and the detention facility **provide written proof of compliance** with this order.
4. Que la Cour envisage une libération humanitaire, étant donné que sa santé demeure en danger.

IV. CONCLUSION

Mr. Luis Ernesto Araujo Molina's health and safety are in **immediate jeopardy** due to the ongoing denial of essential medication.

Judicial intervention is necessary to prevent irreversible harm and to uphold his **constitutional and human rights**.
