STATUS REPORT

On December 16, 2025, the Court entered an opinion and judgment conditionally granting the Petitioner's petition for a writ of habeas corpus. The Court ordered that Respondents provide Petitioner with a bond hearing withing five business days or release Petitioner from custody, and that Respondents file a status report within six business days. On December 23, 2025, undersigned counsel was informed that the bond hearing had been held and the immigration judge ordered Petitioner's release from custody under a \$5,000 bond, but the order was not yet available. Because an executive order closed federal executive departments and agencies on December 24 and December 26, 2025, undersigned counsel does not have additional detail at this time.
